Lead a brief discussion with students using the following questions:

1. Jon's father is mentioned at the beginning of the story.


What did his friends think of him? What do you think Agent S's personality was like? What do you think happened to him?

2. What is Initiation 404?

Have you ever been initiated to anything? Explain the context.

3. Things don't go well for WXT at the end of the story.

What is the moral of this? Have you ever played a trick on a friend? Explain.



How would you entertain yourself if you were alone in the middle of the desert?

5. Agent WXT admits to Jon that he admired his father.

It was thanks to him that WXT became an agent.

What about you? Have you been influenced by someone you admire? Have you ever made a choice based on what that person would have done? Would you like to follow in that person's footsteps?

Ask the students to write an email to Alex A.

They can ask questions about the series and about being a cartoonist and illustrator and offer their impressions of the second volume.

They should learn how to introduce themselves, express their opinion and use courtesy formulas.
